Medial Vowels

- Review with the students the short vowel sounds that they have learned so far: /a/, /i/, /o/, /u/.
- Tell the students that the Lion Puppet will say a word and that you will say a vowel sound that makes his word into a new word. Explain that you want them to say that new word.
- Demonstrate with the following procedure:

Puppet: sit

Teacher: /a/. What's the new word?

Students: sat

Continue with these words:

hit	/a/	(hat)	/O/	(hot)	$/\mathbf{u}/(hut)$
bad	/i/	(bid)	/u/	(bud)	
mat	/i/	(mitt)	/u/	(mutt)	
dug	/o/	(dog)	/i/	(dig)
