Phoneme Replacement

Medial Vowels

- Review with the students the short vowel sounds that they have learned so far: /a/, /i/, /o/, /u/.
- Tell the students that the Lion Puppet will say a word and that you will say a vowel sound that makes his word into a new word. Explain that you want them to say that new word.

- Demonstrate with the following procedure:

Puppet: sit

Teacher: /a/. What's the new word?

Students: sat

- Continue with these words:

hit /a/ (*hat*) /o/ (*hot*) /u/ (*hut*)

bad /i/ (*bid*) /u/ (*bud*)

mat /i/ (*mitt*) /u/ (*mutt*)

dug /o/ (*dog*) /i/ (*dig*)
