## Print and Book Awareness

### Picture-Text Relationship Reading 2.5

Ask the students to look closely at page 35 and tell what they see. What is happening in the picture? (*a blizzard*) Reread the text that accompanies the picture and ask what the picture adds to the text. Why it is better to stay at home during a blizzard? (*Roads are dangerous; it is difficult to see very far; strong winds can blow cars off the road.*) Remind the students that a picture often helps make the text clearer or easier to understand.

### Question Marks Listen/Speak 1.1

Call on a volunteer to come to the **Big Book** and find and point to a question mark on page 37. Ask the students what a question mark shows in a text. (*A question is being asked.*)
