## Exclamation Marks Listen/Speak 1.1

Call on a volunteer to come to the  $\emph{Big Book}$  and find and point to an exclamation mark on page 38. Ask the students what an exclamation mark shows in text (something is being said with feeling). Reread the sentence "It stings!" to demonstrate.

## Headings Reading 2.5; Listen/Speak 1.1
